

## **OBERON SOLAR + STORAGE** FACILITY HIGHLIGHTS

Located in Riverside County, California, Intersect Power's Oberon Solar + Storage Facility generates **679 MWp of solar power**. Built with union labor, American-made solar panels, batteries and steel piles, Oberon features **1 GWh of co-located storage** and produces reliable, low-cost energy equivalent to powering approximately **208,000 homes**. Oberon was the first project to achieve operation through the streamlined approach under the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Desert Renewable Energy Conservation Plan.
